# 2023 MOR Supplementary Regulations

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### 1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Welcome to the Missouri Ozark Rally. On behalf of the organizing committee, Texas County, and the city of Licking, we want to thank you for choosing this event. We hope to make it a great one for everyone. We can't do this without the support of the volunteers, so be sure to thank them whenever you see them. This event takes place in Texas County in Missouri and it would mean a lot to us and them if you could support them whenever you can. Whether you need hotel rooms, food, drinks, gas, car parts, or souvenirs, try to get them in Licking, Houston, or Cabool.

We have many property owners along the stages, most of whom appreciate the show that the competitors put on as they race by, but do remember to be sensible during your stay. Most rally attendees are visitors to the area so do your best to be courteous.

### 2 DESCRIPTION AND ORGANIZATION

- 2.1 This event will be held under the current American Rally Association (ARA) Rules. The Missouri Ozark Rally (MOR) will consist of one day of competition and is part of the ARA Central Regional Championship Series. The event will also count toward the Eastern Ozark Rally Cup which is a three event series of Missouri rallies.
- 2.1.1 This event will not offer Jemba notes or Recce. It will be tulip route book only.
- 2.1.2 Any additional changes or additions to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only by numbered and dated bulletins. The Organizers and/or the Steward shall decide upon any conditions not foreseen in these regulations.
- 2.1.3 The route will be approximately 192 miles in length with approximately 60 miles of competitive stages. All competitive stages will be held on roads that consist primarily of gravel, and will vary somewhat in width and tightness. Roads vary from sweeping, well groomed roads to tight and twisty.
- 2.2 The Official Notice Board is accessed with the Sportity App, which is available for both Apple and Android devices, or at <https://webapp.sportity.com/channel/MOR2023> The password for the event is MOR2023. All official documents, Bulletins, start orders, provisional results, inquiries, and responses will use the Sportity App.
- 2.3 The committee is prepared to conduct this event under any circumstances and will give the contestant competition regardless of weather conditions.

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### 4 ENTRIES

#### 4.1 Entry Procedure:

There is no on-site registration process, all registration including email submission of license information and insurance coverages must be done in advance. Entry and payment must be made online at <http://rallylicense.com/>. ARA will send an email blast to ARA license holders announcing the opening of entry. For assistance with online event registration, contact [ara@ara-rally.com](mailto:ara@ara-rally.com). No entry payments can be accepted at the event.

Entries will be accepted for this rally beginning on July 14, 2023 until July 29, 2023.

**Entry Fee of \$300 will include:** Tulip route book, one Service Packet, use of a single service site, and entry to the event party.

#### 4.2 Withdrawal Policy:

4.2.1 Competitors may revise or withdraw their entry prior to 11:59 PM CDT on Saturday, July 29, 2023 by completing an entry update/withdrawal form available in the Registrar Folder on the Sportity App. Once entries close, withdrawal and entry revisions are actioned by filing an inquiry. Entries that are withdrawn before 11:59 PM CDT on Friday, August 4, 2023 will have the entry fee refunded.

4.2.2 No refunds will be made after the start of the rally.

4.3 Please remember all participants (competitors, service personnel and volunteers) must sign up for an ARA license at <http://rallylicense.com/>. It is free for volunteers. This applies to minors (under the age of 18 years) as well.

### 5 INSURANCE

5.1 Third party liability insurance covering bodily injury and property damage, effective during the competition, will be provided by a policy secured by USAC and displayed on the Official Notice Board.

5.2 Competitors must provide documentation showing bodily injury and property damage liability in amounts equal to or exceeding limits as stated in the current ARA rules for both the rally car and any service vehicles.

5.3 Competitors, service crew members, and all event participants including officials, marshals, staff, stewards, and all other volunteers who have obtained an ARA license (if required), signed

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an ARA waiver, and have been issued and are in possession of an event wristband confirming the signature of the waiver will be covered by a secondary USAC participant accident insurance policy which covers excess medical expenses to their primary medical insurance provider.

### 6 ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

The event will not use the event sponsor advertising space allowed by the current ARA rules. All ARA series advertising must be properly displayed on all competition cars.

### 7 FUEL

Fuel with an octane rating of 93 (R+M) is available at Cenex in Edgar Springs. Fuel with an octane rating of 91 (R+M) is available in Licking and Houston.

### 8 RECONNAISSANCE

There is no reconnaissance (recce) for this event.

### 9 ON-SITE CHECK-IN

- 9.1 Competitor Check-In will be per schedule in section 3. All entry information, including Crew Members, must be complete and final prior to the event. Onsite registration will not be available.
- 9.2 A single email address will be specified by each team to be used for all event communications.
- 9.3 Volunteer check-in will be at Texas County Fairgrounds. All volunteers must sign up in advance. Information will be emailed in advance.

### 10 SCRUTINEERING

- 10.1 Scrutineering will be held at the Licking Volunteer Fire Department, Old Salem Rd, one block east of Main St., Licking, MO 65542. All inspections will be conducted on a first-come, first-served basis. Space is available for truck and trailer parking.
- 10.2 Scrutineering will be held at the following times:  
Friday, August 4, 1600 – 2000  
Saturday, August 5, 0800 – 0900

Log Books will not be issued at the event without prior arrangement. If you need a Log Book, contact [doug@ara-rally.com](mailto:doug@ara-rally.com) before the event.

### 11 SERVICE AREAS

- 11.1 There will be one service location for the event: Town and Country Supermarket, 117 MO-32, Licking, MO 65542.

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The schedules for the service area are included in Appendix 1 – Itinerary, and the service area location is shown in Appendix 2 – Maps.

- 11.2 All service crew are required to have an ARA license and register for the event at <http://rallylicense.com>. Crew may only obtain their license electronically at this website.
- 11.3 Each service vehicle and personnel must be registered. Each vehicle must be licensed and have proof of insurance.
- 11.4 Service spots will be approximately 18'x32'. Teams with special service needs or problems should contact the event chair or Service Coordinator before July 26, 2023.
- 11.5 TRAILERS: Trailers are allowed into the service area and to be parked as directed.
- 11.6 It is recommended that competitors use a plywood or metal support plate underneath their jack stands while using them in service areas.
- 11.7 Service crew must notify the service area coordinator when they leave to retrieve a car.
- 11.8 Please leave the service area cleaner than you found it. Use spill kits and other measures as appropriate.

### 12 TESTING/SHAKEDOWN

This event does not provide for any testing or shakedown.

### 13 FEATURES OF THE RALLY

- 13.1 Parc Exposé: Cars will be parked at the Texas County Fairgrounds.
- 13.2 Timing and scoring will be performed with time cards and logsheets, using rally clocks, per current ARA rules. RallySafe is not used for this event.
- 13.3 An advance packet will be emailed to each team approximately 10 days before the event.
- 13.4 Official Finish:
  - 13.4.1 The Official Finish for competition will be at the MTC IN at service in Licking. The Official Finish is an impound.
- 13.5 Speed Limits:
  - 13.5.1 As a point of general information, the un-posted speed limit in the state of Missouri is 55 miles per hour for paved roads.



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13.5.2 Due to the variety of county ordinances, we have set 35 mph as a maximum transit speed limit in the route book for all unpaved roads, except when they are being used for special stages as part of the rally.

13.5.3 All speed limits are noted in the route book.

### **14 PRIZES/TROPHIES**

14.1 The awards banquet will be held at the Cedar Street Marketplace, 115 Cedar St, Licking, MO 65542. Dinner and drinks will be provided, with trophies presented to the top entrants.

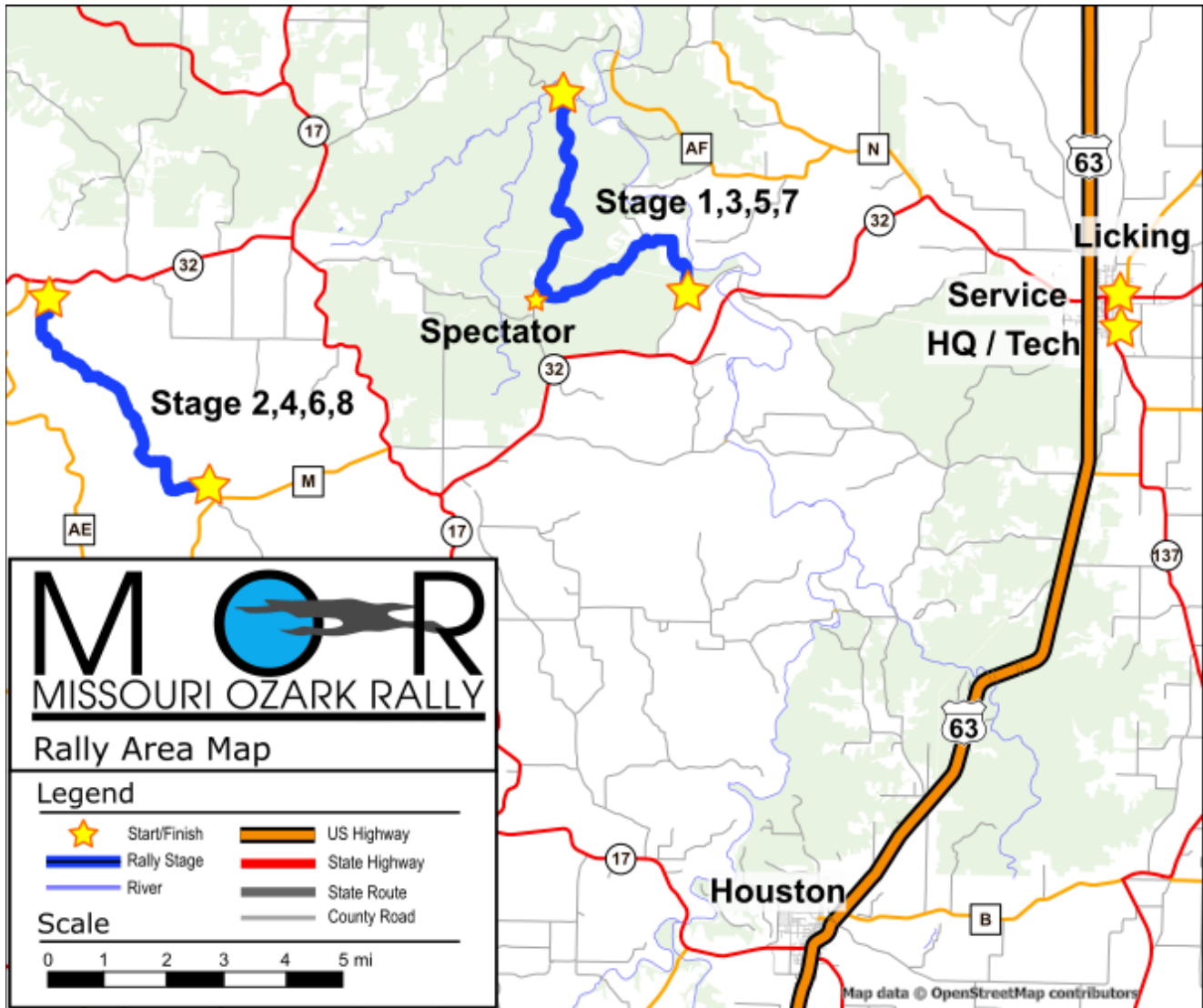
